KLOTZ VADIS D.C.II CONSOLE FOR BBC WALES

Haar/Munich, Germany October 2001, KLOTZ DIGITAL UK is supplying a VADIS D.C.II digital radio console to BBC Wales, KLOTZ DIGITAL's first equipment supply to the BBC. The console will be installed within a new radio studio in Cardiff which is being built to act as a test bed for new technology and experimental working practices. The new studio will also provide additional capacity during BBC Wales's refurbishment of its other radio studios.

The main 20 fader console will be supplemented by a 4 fader unit in the studio which can work as a small stand-**alone** console or it can be linked to the main console for more complex programmes. The VADIS system allows the possibility of networking audio and control to other studios and technical areas. The BBC and KLOTZ DIGITAL are cooperating in the development of a link between the VADIS system and the BBC's Broadcast Network Control System (BNCS), allowing most aspects of the KLOTZ DIGITAL system to be remote controlled.

The console is being supplied to BBC **Wales** via KLOTZ DIGITAL's UK dealer Clyde Broadcast.
