KLOTZ DIGITAL SELLS 1000TH VADIS D.C.II CONSOLE

Munich/Atlanta, November 2006 – KLOTZ DIGITAL today announced that it has just sold its 1000th VADIS D.C.II console to National Public Radio (NPR). The 1000th VADIS D.C.II mixing console is part of a comprehensive order NPR placed to expand its New York City Bureau. In total the facility's two Technical Centres and the Main Control Room will be equipped with two VADIS D.C.II consoles and a router system comprising six VADIS 888 frames with AD, AES/EBU and OCTO-BUS I/O. The system also includes control panels and amplifier modules from KLOTZ DIGITAL's VARIZONE product range for five production studios that interface with each Technical Centre as shared resources. Not only does this combine all components onto one platform to ease the configuration, it also simplifies the installation as the interconnects are all CAT5 cable carrying power, control and audio in both directions. This New York facility connects up via various ISDN and other audio and control circuits to NPR's headquarters in Washington D.C. and the West Coast Production Centre in Culver City, California, which was equipped with KLOTZ DIGITAL's VADIS and D.C.II technology in 2002. The expansion of NPR's New York City Bureau is scheduled to be completed in the first quarter of 2007.
